


The Complaint must route the CAFO through its internal review and approval process which includes the Regional Administrator. Complainant's Counsel anticipates that it will take approximately 30 days to complete this process and file the signed CAFO.

Staying the proceedings will save the resources of the Parties and this tribunal. The Complainant has discussed this motion with the Respondents and they agree with it.
