- 1. Complainant, the Director of the Land and Chemicals Division, United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 5, brought this administrative action seeking a civil penalty under Section 14(a) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), 7 U.S.C. § 136*l*(a).
- 2. On July 22, 2013, EPA filed a Complaint against Respondent, Stepan Company (Stepan). The Complaint alleges that Respondent violated Section 12(a)(1)(E) of FIFRA, 7 U.S.C. § 136j(a)(1)(E), because its agent, Betco Corporation (Betco), distributed or sold an adulterated pesticide on six occasions.

Stipulations

- 3. Respondent admits the jurisdictional allegations in the Complaint and neither admits nor denies the factual allegations in the Complaint.
- 4. Respondent waives any right to contest the allegations in the Complaint and its right to appeal this Consent Agreement and Final Order (CAFO).
 - 5. Respondent certifies that it is complying fully with FIFRA, 7 U.S.C. §§ 136-136y

and its implementing regulations.

- 6. Respondent consents to the assessment of the civil penalty specified in this CAFO and to the terms of this CAFO.
- 7. The parties agree that settling this action without further litigation, in accordance with the terms of this CAFO, is in the public interest.

Civil Penalty

- 8. Respondent agrees to pay the the proposed penalty of \$42,900.
- 9. Within 30 days after the effective date of this CAFO, Respondent must pay a \$42,900 civil penalty for its FIFRA violations. Respondent must pay the penalty by electronic funds transfer, payable to the "Treasurer, United States of America," and sent to:

10. Respondent must send a notice of payment that includes Respondent's name and the case docket number to EPA at the following addresses when it pays the penalty:

- 11. This civil penalty is not deductible for federal tax purposes.
- 12. If Respondent does not pay the civil penalty in a timely manner, EPA may refer the matter to the Attorney General who will recover such amount by action in the appropriate United States district court under Section 14(a)(5) of FIFRA, 7 U.S.C. § 136l(a)(5). The validity, amount and appropriateness of the civil penalty are not reviewable in a collection action.
- 13. Pursuant to 31 C.F.R. § 901.9, Respondent must pay the following on any amount overdue under this CAFO. Interest will accrue on any amount overdue from the date payment was due at a rate established by the Secretary of the Treasury. Respondent must pay a \$15 handling charge each month that any portion of the penalty is more than 30 days past due. In addition, Respondent must pay a 6 percent per year penalty on any principal amount 90 days past due.

General Provisions

- 14. This CAFO resolves only Respondent's liability for federal civil penalties for the violations alleged in the Complaint.
- 15. This CAFO does not affect the rights of EPA or the United States to pursue appropriate injunctive or other equitable relief or criminal sanctions for any violation of law.
 - 16. This CAFO does not affect Respondent's responsibility to comply with FIFRA and

other applicable federal, state and local laws.

- 17. This CAFO is a "Final Order" for purposes of EPA's FIFRA Enforcement Response Policy.
 - 18. The terms of this CAFO bind Respondent, its successors and assigns.
- 19. Each person signing this agreement certifies that he or she has the authority to sign for the party whom he or she represents and to bind that party to its terms.
 - 20. Each party agrees to bear its own costs and attorneys fees in this action.
 - 21. This CAFO constitutes the entire agreement between the parties.
