Dear Mr. Stricklin:

This letter is to inform you of the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Administrative Orders (Orders) issued to you, as the owner and/or operator of the Alcova Dam Trailer Park and Eagle Creek RV public water systems, on August 30, 2007 (amended April 15, 2008) and October 12, 2005, respectively. The EPA has determined that you have complied with the requirements of the Orders and have paid the associated penalty, and therefore we will close them at this time.

Please be aware that you are still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (drinking water regulations), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the drinking water regulations may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties of up to \$37,500 per day of violation.
