
Dear Chairman Stafne:

This letter is to inform you of the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Emergency Administrative Order, Docket No. SDWA-08-2009-0027, issued on January 28, 2009, and amended on April 14, 2009. Based on the information provided to EPA, EPA has determined that the Fort Peck Utilities Commission has complied with the requirements of the Emergency Administrative Order.

Please be aware that the Fort Peck Utilities Commission is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations ("NPDWRs"), 40 C.F.R. Part 141. Violation of the NPDWRs may result in a court-imposed injunction or penalties of up to \$37,500 per day of violation.
