Dear Mr. Harelson:

This letter is to inform you of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) decision to close the Administrative Order for Compliance on Consent (Order), Docket No. CWA-08-2017-0020, issued to the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) on August 7, 2017 and subsequently amended on March 2, 2021. EPA has determined that CDOT has no remaining obligations under the Order and, therefore, is closing the Order at this time.

Please be aware that CDOT is still required to comply with the Clean Water Act (Act), its implementing regulations, and permits, including section 402 of the Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1342, 40 C.F.R. 122.26 and CDOT's municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) permit (COS000005). Violations of the Act, its implementing regulations, or permits may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties of up to \$59,973 per day for each violation.
