Dear Mayor Daggs:

On September 30, 2008, the above referenced Findings of Violation and Order for Compliance on Consent (Order) was filed with the Regional Hearing Clerk under the authority of Section 309(a)(3) of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1319(a)(3). On February 13, 2013, the City of Ackley submitted its latest semiannual report covering the third and fourth quarters of calendar year 2012. The EPA has reviewed that report and additional information received from the City's engineer on March 25, 2013, and has determined that the requirements of the Order have been adequately met. This letter serves as a notification to you that the EPA is terminating the Order as provided in Paragraph 34 of the Order. The EPA's decision to terminate the Order is conditioned upon the accuracy of your representations to the EPA in response to the requirements of the Order.

The effect of this termination is limited to the requirements imposed under the Order. The EPA reserves all of its authorities, both legal and equitable, under the CWA and any other statutory, regulatory, or common law authorities of the United States.
