Relief Requested.

Respondent CASTLE FAMILY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

respectfully requests an order extending the time for it to answer the complaint by a minimum of 60 calendar days, or no sooner than January 4, 2008.

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2. Authority and Argument.

This motion is made pursuant to 40 CFR §22.7(b) which provides that the "Presiding Officer may grant an extention of time for filing any document; upon timely motion of a party to the proceeding, for good cause shown...". This motion is submitted herein based on the Declaration of Lisa Woods Munger and the records and files herein.

This matter involves the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) complaint assessing penalties against Respondents for alleged violations of the Clean Water Act, with respect to certain amounts of fill dirt allegedly placed on Respondent Castle Family's property in Hawaii. The parties are in the process of settling this matter, and as such Respondent, Castle Family seeks to avoid the need and expense of answering the complaint and setting a hearing, while good faith settlement discussions are on-going.

It is hoped that settlement documents will be prepared and presented by the EPA by early November, 2007. Respondent, Castle Family and EPA are investigating the possibility of a Supplemental Environmental Project ("SEP"). EPA is close to getting management approval for a SEP option for Respondents to consider, in lieu of an all cash penalty.

Respondent, Frank Coluccio Construction's Hawaii office received the EPA's complaint on October 9, 2007. Respondent Castle Family received the complaint thereafter. Respondent Castle Family hereby requests a sixty day

extension of time within which to respond to the complaint, up to and including January 4, 2008. The additional time is necessary due to pending settlement discussions.
