This is an Addendum to the Administrative Order (Order) issued to Tata Chemicals (Soda Ash) Partners (Company) on April 22, 2020. The purpose of this letter is to approve the Company's February 28,2023 schedule (Schedule) for coming into consistent compliance with the trihalomethanes (TTHMs) and haloacetic acids (HAA5s) maximum contaminant level (MCL). The Schedule is hereby incorporated into the Order pursuant to paragraph 18. Each milestone and deadline specified below is an enforceable provision of the Order.

Within 10 calendar days of completing all steps included in the above Schedule, please notify the EPA of the project's completion as required by the Order. The Order also requires the Company to achieve

and maintain compliance with the TTHMs and HAA5s MCL by the final date specified in the approved Schedule. The EPA is authorized to seek penalties if these deadlines are not met. If the Company has a reasonable basis to believe it may be unable to meet any deadline in the Schedule, it must notify the EPA well in advance of the Scheduled deadline to request an extension. The EPA may, in its discretion, consider granting an extension.

As a reminder, the Company is required to provide the EPA with quarterly progress reports by June 1, 2023.
