Dear Sarah,

Enclosed you will find the executed Expedited Settlement Agreement and Final Order ("Order") (Docket No.: RCRA-05-2024-0016) resolving alleged violations identified at the Bridge Point McCook 3, LLC ("Bridge") facility located at 9130 W. 55th Street in McCook, Illinois. Also enclosed is notice of payment of the \$7,500 penalty in accordance with Sections 8 and 9 of the Order.

Consistent with our discussions and your direction, this letter also confirms that Bridge is not currently a generator of regulated hazardous waste at the 55th Street facility in McCook and, therefore, has no obligation at present to prepare a contingency plan, provide training for its employees or comply with other requirements imposed on generators of hazardous waste under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act and its implementing regulations ("RCRA"). Should Bridge's future operations at the McCook facility involve the generation of such RCRA wastes, Bridge will ensure that appropriate steps are taken to comply with all applicable regulations governing generators of such wastes, including preparing such plans and providing required training to relevant facility personnel.

Please let me know if you have any questions or concerns regarding Bridge's satisfaction of its obligations, and the full and final resolution of its liability, under the Order.
