On February 7, 2025, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency issued a Notice of Violation and a Compliance Order/Settlement Agreement (Settlement Agreement) for a violation of the Federal underground storage tank (UST) regulations at the Fort and Penn facility located at 17013 Fort, Riverview, Michigan. The violation was identified during an EPA UST inspection conducted on December 4, 2024.

On April 10, 2025, EPA received your supporting documentation that the violation has been corrected. On March 26, 2025, EPA received the signed Settlement Agreement. Your payment of \$815.00 was confirmed by our finance office on March 25, 2025. The Settlement Agreement states that it is effective upon EPA's final approval. I have enclosed a signed and dated copy of the approved Settlement Agreement. The original Settlement Agreement will remain in EPA's file. We also have accepted and processed your payment as part of the settlement process.
