On June 4, 2025, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency issued a Notice of Violation and a Compliance Order/Settlement Agreement (Settlement Agreement) for a violation of the Federal underground storage tank (UST) regulations at Trinity Health Oakland Hospital facility located at 44405 Woodward Avenue, Pontiac, Michigan. The violation was identified during an EPA UST inspection conducted on April 9, 2025.

On July 7, 2025, EPA received your signed copy of the Settlement Agreement and your supporting documentation that the violation has been corrected. Your payment of \$815 was confirmed by our finance office on July 18, 2025. The Settlement Agreement states that it is effective upon EPA's final approval. I have enclosed a signed and dated copy of the approved Settlement Agreement. The original Settlement Agreement will remain in EPA's file. We also have accepted and processed your payment as part of the settlement process.
