

# Public Notice: Proposed settlement with Pacific Steel and Recycling for Clean Water Act violations in Idaho

**Publish Date:** February 20, 2026

## Summary

EPA is providing notice of a proposed administrative penalty settlement with Pacific Steel and Recycling for violations of the Clean Water Act at its facility located in **Boise, Idaho**.

EPA alleges that the respondent failed to comply with its National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit (IDR053096) at its facility. The permit covers discharges of pollutants into the **Boise River**.

Alleged violations include failure to conduct all required quarterly visual assessments, failure to properly summarize visual assessments in annual reports, and failure to maintain facility inspection reports with the facility's Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan.

This action is being simultaneously commenced and concluded in a legal document called an *Expedited Settlement Agreement*. Under the proposed agreement (see related documents below), the company will pay a **civil penalty of \$2,578** and has certified that the alleged violations have been corrected.
