The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed the District of Columbia Department of Energy and Environment's Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP) Completion Report. The report describes the activities conducted at the northwest corner of Florida Avenue, NW and 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, NW, the expenditures for the SEP and the environmental benefit of the SEP. The SEP converted 3,149 square feet of impervious surface into 1,155 feet of permeable pavement and 1,994 square feet of native plant beds and tree planters. The actions are expected to capture thousands of gallons of stormwater that otherwise go into the combined sewer system. The SEP will be treating a greater area and was built at a greater expense than was called for in the Consent Agreement and Final Order. Based on the SEP Completion Report and its appendices, EPA has concluded that the SEP has been satisfactorily completed.
