### FOURTH JOINT STATUS REPORT

Comes now Complainant United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") and Respondents Carbon Injection Systems LLC, Scott Forster and Eric Lofquist (hereinafter "Parties"), through counsel, pursuant to the December 27, 2011, Order on Motion for Third Party Discovery and Order Postponing Hearing and Revising Case Schedule in the above-referenced matter and respectfully file this Fourth Joint Status Report.
