

RESPONDENTS' MOTION TO CONTINUE STAY

On 4 May 2011, this tribunal granted a stay of 60 days following the counsel of record's heart attack. Since the tribunal issued its order on 4 May 2011, the parties have diligently pursued settlement. However, due to vacation schedules and a requirement for management review, the agency has not yet made an ability to pay settlement offer. Moreover, while he is making good progress, the respondents' counsel of record, Fred Triem, is still recovering from his April heart attack and open heart surgery.

For the reasons set out in the accompanying status report and memorandum in support of Respondents' motion to continue stay, Respondents move the tribunal to continue the present stay for an additional 45 days to allow time for Mr. Triem to recover and the parties to complete settlement negotiations.


