### EXPEDITED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

**DOCKET NO:** CAA-04-2007-8014(b)

This ESA is issued to:

Marianna Industries, Inc. 11222 I Street Omaha, Nebraska 68137

for violating Section 112(r)(7) of the Clean Air Act.

This Expedited Settlement Agreement (ESA) is being entered into by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 4, the Director of the Air, Pesticides and Toxics Management Division (Complainant), and by Marianna Industries, Inc. (Respondent), pursuant to Section 113(a)(3) and (d) of the Clean Air Act (the "Act"), 42 U.S.C. § 7413(a)(3) and (d), and by 40 CFR § 22.13(b).

#### **ALLEGED VIOLATIONS**

Based on a compliance monitoring inspection conducted on June 22, 2006, at the Respondent's Marianna of Memphis, Inc., facility located at 1178 Pope Street, Memphis, Tennessee, EPA alleges that the Respondent violated the Act's Chemical Accident Prevention Program when:

Respondent did not provide evidence that it has updated and revalidated the process hazard analysis at least every five years as required by 40 CFR § 68.67(f); and

Respondent did not provide evidence that it had, at least every three years, evaluated its compliance with the prevention program requirements and certified that its procedures and practices are adequate and are being followed as required by 40 CFR § 68.79(a).

#### **SETTLEMENT**

In consideration of Respondent's size, its full compliance history, its good faith effort to comply, and other factors as justice may require, and upon consideration of the entire record the parties enter into the ESA in order to settle the violations cited above, for the total penalty amount of \$420.

This settlement is subject to the following terms and conditions: the Respondent by signing below admits the jurisdictional allegations contained herein, neither admits nor denies the specific factual allegations contained herein, and consents to the assessment of the penalty as stated above; Respondent waives its rights to a hearing afforded by Section 113(d)(2)(A) of the Act, 42 U.S.C § 7413(d)(2)(A), and to contest the allegations contained in this ESA; and each party to this action shall bear its own costs and fees, if any.

Respondent has corrected the alleged violations listed in this ESA. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of \$420. Please note that payment should not be made until after Respondent receives a copy of the fully executed ESA. Within fifteen (15) days after receiving a copy of the fully executed ESA, the Respondent shall send a cashier's check or certified check (payable to the "Treasurer, United States of America") in the amount of \$420, in payment of the full penalty amount to the following address:

The Respondent's name and the Docket Number of this ESA <u>must be included on</u> the check. The Docket Number is located at the top left corner of the first page of this ESA.
