This letter is to inform you of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Administrative Order (Order), Docket No. SDWA-08-2010-0034, issued to the Park County School District #6 (the District), owner and/or operator of the Wapiti Elementary School water system, on April 19, 2010. EPA has determined that the District has complied with the requirements of the Administrative Order and therefore we will close the Order at this time.

Please be aware that the District is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (NPDWRs), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the NPDWRs may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties of up to \$37,500 per day of violation.
