At: 48000 Ebbtide Lane, Port Richey, Pasco County, EPA's approval of the Expedited Settlement without further Florida, American Marina Enterprises, Inc. (Respondent) notice. discharged approximately 450 gallons of oil in violation of Section 311(b)(3) of the Clean Water Act (the Act), as noted on the attached FINDINGS and ALLEGED VIOLATIONS FORM (Form), which is hereby incorporated by reference.

EPA finds the Respondent's conduct is subject to the discharge prohibition of Section 311(b)(3) of the Act, as described in that statute and further described by 40 CFR § 311(b)(3) and that EPA has jurisdiction over the Respondent and the Respondent's conduct as described in the form. Respondent does not contest the Findings in the Form, and This Expedited Settlement is binding on the parties signing waives any objections it may have to EPA's jurisdiction.

EPA is authorized to enter into this Expedited Settlement not sign and return this Expedited Settlement as presented under the authority vested in the Administrator of EPA by Section 311(b)(6)(B)(i) of the Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1321(b)(6)(B)(i), as amended by the Oil Pollution Act of 1990, and by 40 CFR § 22.13(b). The parties enter into this Expedited Settlement in order to settle civil violations described in the Form for a penalty of \$500.00. Respondent consents to the assessment of this penalty.

This Expedited Settlement is also subject to the following terms and conditions: Respondent certifies, subject to civil and criminal penalties for making a false submission to the Title (print): United States Government, that it has investigated the cause of the spill, it has cleaned up the spill pursuant to federal signature: requirements at a cost of \$ 260, 50, and it has taken corrective actions that will prevent future spills. Respondent also by signature of this Settlement Agreement agrees to payment of the penalty assessed. Upon written execution of this Agreement Respondent shall submit J. I. Palmer, Jr. payment within 7 days by certified check or electronic runds Regional Administrator transfer for \$500.00 payable to the "US Environmental Protection Agency CWA-311". Instructions on how to make this payment will be included in the written notice that IT IS SO ORDERED: will be issued when the Expedited Settlement Agreement becomes effective.

Upon signing and returning this Expedited Settlement to EPA, Respondent waives the opportunity for a hearing or appeal pursuant to Section 311 of the Act, and consents to

After this Expedited Settlement becomes effective, EPA will take no further action against the Respondent for the violations of Section 311(b)(3) of the Act described in the Form. However, EPA does not waive any rights to take any enforcement action for any other past, present, or future violations by the Respondent of Section 311(b)(3) of the Act or of any other federal statute or regulation. By its first The Respondent admits being subject to Section signature, EPA ratifies the Findings and Alleged Violations set forth in the Form.

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ALLEGED CIVIL VIOLATIONS - DOCKET NO. CWA-04-2006-5029

American Marina Enterprises, Inc., Respondent, is a corporation organized under the laws of Florida with a place of business located at 4800 Ebbtide Lane, Port Richey, Florida 34668. The Respondent is a person within the meaning of Section 311(a)(7) of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. §1321(a)(7).

Respondent is the owner of an onshore facility within the meaning of Section 311(a)(10) of the Act, 33 U.S.C. §1321(a)(10), which is located at or near 4800 Ebbtide Lane, Port Richey, Pasco County, Florida ('facility').

Section 311(b)(3) of the Act prohibits the discharge of oil into or upon the navigable waters of the United States or adjoining shorelines in such quantities that have been determined may be harmful to the public health or welfare or environment of the United States.

For purposes of Section 311(b)(3) and (b)(4) of the Act, 33 U.S.C. §1321(b)(3) and (b)(4), discharges of oil into or upon the navigable waters of the United States in such quantities that have been determined may be harmful to the public health or welfare or environment of the United States are defined in 40 C.F.R. §110.3 to include discharges of oil that (1) violate applicable water quality standards or, (2) cause a film or a sheen upon or discoloration of the surface of the water or adjoining shorelines or, (3) cause a sludge or emulsion to be deposited beneath the surface of the water or upon the adjoining shorelines.

On May 9, 2006, Respondent discharged an estimated 450 gallons of oil as defined in Section 311(a)(1) of the Act, 33 U.S.C. §1321(a)(1), and 40 C.F.R. §110.1, from its facility into or upon the Pithlachascotee River which discharges into the Gulf of Mexico and adjoining shorelines.

The Pithlachascotee River which discharges into the Gulf of Mexico is a "navigable water of the United States" subject to the jurisdiction of Section 311 of the Act as defined in Section 502(7) of the Act, 33 U.S.C. §1362(7), and 40 C.F.R. §110.1.

Respondent's May 9, 2006 discharge of oil from its facility caused a sheen upon or discoloration of the surface of the adjoining shoreline of the Pithlachascotee River which discharges into the Gulf of Mexico or caused a sludge or emulsion to be deposited beneath the surface, and therefore, was in a quantity that has been determined may be harmful under 40 C.F.R. §110.3, which implements Section 311(b)(3) and (b)(4) of the Act.

Respondent's May 9, 2006 discharge of oil from its facility into or upon the Pithlachascotee River which discharges into the Gulf of Mexico and adjoining shorelines in a quantity that has been determined may be harmful under 40 C.F.R. §110.3 violated Section 311(b)(3) of the Act. Pursuant to Section 311(b)(6)(B)(i) of the Act, and 40 C.F.R. 19.4, the Respondent is liable for civil penalties of up to \$11,000 per violation, up
