INFORMATIVE MOTION TO WITHDRAW THE COMPLAINT


The Administrative Complaint (“Complaint”) in this matter was issued under the authority vested in the Administrator of the United States Environmental Protection Agency (“EPA”) by Section 311(b)(6)(B)(ii) of the Clean Water Act (“Act”), 33 U.S.C. § 1321(b)(6)(B)(ii). The Administrator has delegated the authority to the Regional Administrator of EPA, Region 2, who in turn has delegated it to the Director, Emergency and Remedial Response Division (“ERRD”) of EPA, Region 2, the Complainant in this matter.

The Complaint alleged that Casie Ecology Oil Salvage, Inc. (“Respondent”) was in violation of Section 311(j) of the Act for failing or refusing to comply with regulations found at 40 C.F.R. Part 112 to which Respondent was subject at its facility located at 3rd and L Streets, Millville, New Jersey. Specifically, Respondent failed to submit a Facility Response Plan (“FRP”) by February 18, 1993 or by August 20, 1994. The Complaint proposed to assess a

penalty of one hundred three thousand dollars (\$103,000.00) and required compliance with the regulations found at 40 C.F.R. Part 112.

Since the issuance of the Complaint, Respondent has ceased operations, due to bankruptcy, and has sought to sell the property where the Facility is located. As such, the Complainant hereby withdraws, by right and without prejudice, the Complaint, Docket No. CWA-02-2007-3813. This action is taken pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 22.14(d) of the Consolidated Rules of Practice.
