Dear Mr. Simpson:

This letter is to inform you of the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Administrative Order (Order) issued to the Wyoming Department of State Parks and Cultural Resources (SPCR) on October 20, 2010. The EPA has determined that, despite some instances of late reporting of monitoring results to the EPA, SPCR has complied with the requirements of the Order and therefore we will close it at this time. It is important that all monitoring results are timely reported to the EPA.

Please be aware that SPCR is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (drinking water regulations), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the drinking water regulations may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties of up to \$37,500 per day of violation.
