must now finalize settlement documents, which will require Town officials and staff to produce a detailed analysis and description of the proposed SEP.

In addition, the Town notes that its lead counsel will be out of the country between October 21 and October 30, 2009, and therefore will be unavailable during that time.

The Town further states that no prejudice will result from the granting of this extension where both the Town and EPA have agreed to a settlement of this matter that will avoid the time and expense of any further administrative proceedings. EPA, through its senior enforcement counsel, has assented to this Motion.

WHEREFORE, the Town asks the Presiding Officer to issue an order granting this assented to Motion and extending the time period the Town has to answer the Administrative Complaint in this matter to December 14, 2009.
