
The Complainant ("U.S. EPA") and Respondent, Agrimor Int'l Co. ("Agrimor"),  
move this Court to extend the ADR process for another fourteen days as follows:

(1) On May 27, 2010, the Chief Administrative Law Judge referred this case to  
Judge Spencer Nissen to serve as the ADR Judge.

(2) The initial ADR period was to expire on June 18, 2010, however, on June 18,  
2010, in response to the parties' joint motion for a thirty day extension, Judge Nissen  
extended ADR until July 19, 2010. During a conference call on July 19, 2010, the parties  
advised Judge Nissen that an additional short extension of the ADR period could help  
resolve this matter without the need for litigation. Therefore, the parties jointly request  
that the ADR process be extended for fourteen days until August 2, 2010.

(3) The undersigned has been authorized by counsel for Agrimor to file this Joint  
Motion on behalf of both parties.
