Pursuant to paragraph 20 of the Administrative Order (Order) issued January 5, 2012 to Woodenshoe Pipeline Company (Respondent), this Addendum to the Order incorporates the plan and schedule for completing system modifications as outlined in the May 4, 2012 email to EPA from Epic Engineering on behalf of Respondent. This letter constitutes the written approval by EPA of Respondent's schedule shown below.

Please note that EPA expects this approved schedule to be met. While not creating any right to an extension, EPA in its discretion may consider granting an extension to compliance order deadlines under limited circumstances. If unexpected events occur that are beyond Respondent's control and that may require Respondent to request an extension of these deadlines, Respondent is responsible for notifying EPA well in advance of the deadline dates. EPA will not consider extending these deadlines without a clear justification for their need. Respondent must provide the following information in writing for any request for extensions: a description of the work that has been completed and the additional work that may not be completed by the deadline dates; the unexpected events that have occurred or may occur and how Respondent has attempted to foresee and use its best efforts to




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overcome these obstacles; and proposed new deadline dates with justification for the length of the proposed new deadlines.

As a reminder, Respondent is required to submit quarterly progress reports to EPA and UTDEQ within 10 days of the end of each calendar quarter per paragraph 21 (page 4) of the Order.

Please be advised that Respondent is required to comply with all provisions of the Order. Penalties for failing to comply are set forth in the Order.
