Dear Ms. Knudsen:

On July 28, 2009, the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Administrative Order, Docket No. SDWA-08-2009-0012, ordering you, as owner and/or operator of the Shaker's Steak and Ale (now known as Cheffys) public water system (the system) to comply with various regulations issued by EPA under the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA), 42 U.S.C. § 300f et seg.

Our records indicate that you, the Respondent, are in violation of the Administrative Order (the Order). Among other things, the Order included the following requirements (quoted from items 9 and 13 of the Order section on page 3 of the Order):

 Upon receipt of this Order, Respondent shall monitor for total coliform bacteria monthly. ARM 17.38.215(1)(b). Respondent shall report analytical results to EPA and the State within the first 10 days following the month in which sample results are received, as required by the drinking water regulations. 40 C.F.R. § 141.31(a).

Respondent failed to monitor for total coliform bacteria in September 2009.

 Upon the effective date of this Order, Respondent shall report any violation of the total coliform monitoring requirements to EPA and the State within ten days after Respondent learns of it. 40 C.F.R. § 141.21(g)(2).

Respondent failed to report to EPA its failure to monitor for total coliform violations in September 2009.

EPA is considering additional enforcement action, including assessment of penalties, as a result of the ongoing non-compliance with the Order detailed above. Violating an Administrative Order may lead to (1) a penalty of up to \$37,500 per day per violation of the Order, and/or (2) a court injunction ordering compliance.
