On May 25, 2011, EPA issued an Emergency Administrative Order (Order) to the Crow Tribe and Bureau of Indian Affairs. The Order was issued following a loss of pressure in the Crow Agency water system as a result of flooding. This letter is to inform you of the EPA's decision to close the Order.

All requirements of the Order have been met. Required special samples were collected and all showed the water to be safe to drink. The system is now on its regular monthly monitoring schedule. I appreciate all efforts to maintain an adequate level of staffing for the water plant.
