**ORDER TERMINATING ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION  
PROCESS AND REQUESTING ASSIGNMENT OF CASE TO LITIGATION**

On January 2, 2008 an Order was issued initiating the Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR), process and appointing the undersigned as a neutral. The Order provided that unless terminated earlier at the request of either party or an extension is granted, the ADR process would terminate on March 3, 2008. As allowed, an extension was granted twice but ADR could not be extended beyond May 2, 2008.
