On August 30, 2007, the above referenced Findings of Violation and Order for Compliance on Consent (Order) was filed with the Regional Hearing Clerk under the authority of Section 309(a)(3) of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1319(a)(3). On January 28, 2015, the City submitted its final report summarizing the implementation of its previously approved Plan of Action. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has reviewed this report and has determined that the requirements of the Order have been adequately met. This letter serves as a notification to you that the EPA is terminating the Order as provided in Paragraph 55 of the Order. The EPA's decision to terminate the Order is conditioned upon the accuracy of your representations to the EPA in response to the requirements of the Order.

The effect of this termination is limited to the requirements imposed under the Order. The EPA reserves all of its authorities, both legal and equitable, under the CWA and any other statutory, regulatory, or common law authorities of the United States.
