This letter is to inform you of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Emergency Administrative Order (Order), Docket No. SDWA-08-2013-0003, issued to the Skull Valley Band of Goshute Indians, as owner of the Skull Valley Public Water System (System), on November 20, 2012.

The EPA is closing the Order at this time following deactivation by the EPA of the Skull Valley system as a "public water system" on November 25, 2013, which followed information from the Band that the System does not regularly serve 25 or more persons per day for at least 60 days per year.
