During a phone conversation with Cynthia Peterson on December 29, 2009, you requested an extension of time to comply with the Class V well closure requirements contained in the Proposed Compliance Order, Penalty Complaint, And Notice of Opportunity for Hearing dated September 25, 2009. With this letter, EPA acknowledges receipt of your request.

Your request for an extension is granted, making the deadline for permanent well closure February 22, 2010. The extension includes the requirement to submit documentation of well closure, which will now be due on March 24, 2010.

In the documentation of closure, please include the date of closure; a written description of the closure; receipts from any contractors involved in the well closure; photos documenting that the floor drains have been permanently plugged; and any other documents that evidence the closure. Send the notice and documentation to:
