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

**MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF
RESPONDENTS JOHN A. BIEWER
COMPANY, INC. AND BIEWER
LUMBER, LLC'S MOTION FOR
ACCELERATED DECISION**

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Complainant has not even asserted that Biewer Lumber, LLC has ever acted through JAB Toledo or in any way disregarded the separate corporate status of the two companies. As such, Complainant's veil-piercing theory is wholly inapplicable, as a matter of law, because there is no veil to be pierced in the first instance.

Even if there were a corporate veil to be pierce, Complainant has advanced no plausible theory or explanation of how a corporation could possibly be subject to a veil-piercing claim based on actions or inactions that *pre-date* its existence. Thus, this Presiding Judge should rule that, as a matter of law, Biewer Lumber, LLC cannot be indirectly liable for JAB Toledo's RCRA liability under the Ohio common law of corporate veil piercing.


CONCLUSION


