Dear Mr. Salisbury:

Pursuant to the Administrative Order (Order) issued on January 14, 2010, to Power Resources, Inc. (dba Cameco Resources), as owner and operator of the Smith Ranch public water system, on March 10, 2010, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) provided written approval of Power Resources, Inc.'s plan and schedule for actions aimed at ensuring compliance with the maximum contaminant level for total coliform bacteria. This 2nd Administrative Order Addendum letter advises Power Resources, Inc. that weekly reporting of the residual chlorine results collected by Power Resources, Inc., required under EPA's letter of March 10, 2010, is no longer required.

While that prior requirement is now discontinued, EPA reminds Power Resources, Inc. that it is required to continue to comply with other provisions of the compliance plan and schedule, as well as provisions of the Order. EPA appreciates Power Resources, Inc. – Smith Ranch's ongoing cooperation in this regard.
