Dear Mayor Vieyra:

This Addendum to the Administrative Order (Order) issued June 18, 2009, to the Town of Rock River (the Town) approves the plan submitted by Aspen-Banner Engineering on behalf of the Town on May 14, 2010. The plan and schedule shown below is hereby incorporated into the Order per paragraph 12 (page 3) of the Order. Please note that this Addendum does not negate the Town's prior violations regarding timely submittal of a compliance plan and compliance schedule.

Table with 2 columns: Action, Completion Date. Rows include Water quality testing, Best available technology review, Prepare construction documents, Bid project, Award contract, Construction, and System in service.

As a reminder, the Town is required to submit quarterly progress reports to EPA within 10 days of the end of each calendar quarter per paragraph 13 (page 3) of the Order.

Please note that EPA expects this approved schedule to be met. While not creating any right to an extension, EPA in its discretion may consider granting an extension to compliance order deadlines under limited circumstances. If unexpected events occur that are beyond the Town's control and that may require the Town to request an extension of these deadlines, the Town is responsible for notifying EPA well in advance of the deadline dates. EPA will not

consider extending these deadlines without a clear justification for their need. The Town must provide the following information in writing for any request for extensions:

1. a description of the work that has been completed and the additional work that may not be completed by the deadline dates,
2. the unexpected events that have occurred or may occur and how the Town has attempted to foresee and use its best efforts to overcome these obstacles, and
3. proposed new deadline dates with justification for the length of the proposed new deadlines.
