1. This amendment modifies paragraph 29 of the Consent Agreement and Final Order (CAFO) filed with the Regional Hearing Clerk on August 17, 2016 in the above-referenced matter. Except as specifically set forth herein, all provisions of the August 17, 2016 CAFO shall remain in full force and effect.


2. Paragraph 29 is replaced in its entirety as follows:

Respondent must complete, by **July 31, 2017**, a supplemental environmental project (SEP) designed to protect the environment and public health by replacing an existing boiler with two energy efficient boilers at Cicero School District 99, which results in providing heat in a more sustainable manner, thus reducing emissions of volatile organic compounds and particulate matter. Respondent shall implement the SEP in accordance with the SEP Statement of Work (SOW) attached to this CAFO as Attachment A.


