

Dear Mr. Vanzee:

On July 18, 2008, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Emergency Administrative Order (Order) under section 1431 of the Safe Drinking Water Act (the Act), 40 U.S.C. § 300i, to you, owner and/or operator of the Flying X Ranch Mobile Home Park public water system (the System). This letter confirms the verbal notice provided to Michelle Arrick, Office Administrator at Flying X Ranch Mobile Home Park, by Shawn McCaffrey of EPA on August 28, 2008 that weekly bacteriological monitoring in the distribution system is no longer required and may be reduced to monthly monitoring (two samples per month). This notice is based on bacteriological monitoring conducted on August 5, August 12, and August 20, 2008 which were analyzed as total coliform negative. Monthly bacteriological monitoring shall be conducted until you are notified by EPA that sampling may be reduced to quarterly. The System is required to comply with all other provisions of the Order. Penalties for failing to comply are set forth in the Order.
