

**ORDER GRANTING**  
**COMPLAINANT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

On October 26, 2009, the Court issued a Prehearing Order directing the parties to make their initial prehearing exchanges by Friday, December 18, 2009. Complainant filed a Motion to Extend Time for Filing Prehearing Exchange, dated December 14, 2009, in which Complainant requests that the Court extend the deadline for the parties to make their initial prehearing exchanges by two months because the parties reached a settlement agreement earlier this month in which the parties agreed to an amount for settlement and the terms of payment. Complainant seeks an extension to allow the parties to have an adequate opportunity to review the documentation effecting the agreement without "having to concern themselves with litigation deadlines that in virtual certitude will not be required." Motion at 3. Complainant relates that Respondent joins in its request for an extension.

Upon consideration, the Court grants Complainant's request. Two months is a reasonable period of time for the parties to finalize their settlement agreement. Accordingly, the Court directs the parties to submit a finalized Consent Agreement and Final Order by February 19, 2009, or in the alternative, file their initial prehearing exchanges by that date.

So ordered.


