
On October 17, 2011, the above referenced Findings of Violation and Order for Compliance (Order) was filed with the Regional Hearing Clerk under the authority of Section 309(a)(3) of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1319(a)(3). The Order required the City to implement numerous improvements to its approved Pretreatment Program bringing it into compliance with the requirements of the General Pretreatment Regulations, 40 CFR Part 403. One of the requirements was for the City to develop local limits for its two wastewater treatment plants and have them approved by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources before incorporating them into permits issued to its Significant Industrial Users. Copies of the permits have been sent to the Environmental Protection Agency who has determined that the local limits were developed and applied properly. This completes all outstanding requirements of the Order.

This letter serves as a notification to you that the EPA is terminating the Order as provided in Paragraph 34 of the Order. The EPA's decision to terminate the Order is conditioned upon the accuracy of your representations to the EPA in response to the requirements of the Order.

The effect of this termination is limited to the requirements imposed under the Order. The EPA reserves all of its authorities, both legal and equitable, under the CWA and any other statutory, regulatory, or common law authorities of the United States.
