Respondent's timely provision of an EPA-approved pamphlet constitutes grounds for a defense against the allegations set forth in the Complaint.

25. Respondent Denies the allegation that he did not provide an EPA-approved pamphlet to the lessees identified in Paragraph 23 of the Complaint before they were obligated under a

contract to lease target housing and, therefore, Denies the alleged violation of the cited statute and regulation in Paragraph 25 of the Complaint.

26. Respondent repeats and re-alleges the Answers to Paragraphs 1 through 25 of the Complaint.
