

REPORT RECOMMENDING CONTINUATION
OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCESS

The Report approved January 9, 2008 provides that this alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process terminates February 7, 2008. The recommendation of this Report is that the ADR process be continued for a final month, to March 7, 2008.

This continuation of the ADR process is recommended because the parties' negotiations have developed an agreement in principle but additional time is needed for the preparation and filing of the Consent Agreement and Final Order ("CAFO").¹ The parties' chances of achieving a settlement are sufficient to justify the continuation. The parties are commended for their success in negotiating their agreement.


