Dear Mr. Casey:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has reviewed Naval Support Activity Annapolis (NSAA) compliance with the Federal Facility Compliance Agreement (FFCA), referenced above, which was issued by EPA to NSAA and filed with the Regional Hearing Clerk, U.S. EPA, Region 3 on August 9, 2018. The FFCA required NSAA to comply with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Discharge Permit issued by the State of Maryland, NPDES Permit No. MD0023523. Based on EPA's review, EPA has determined that NSAA has provided EPA the required documentation that the requirements set forth in the FFCA has been fully completed and implemented. Therefore, EPA is terminating the FFCA.

Please note that NSAA must still comply with any applicable Clean Water Act (CWA) requirements and any applicable implementing federal regulations. Failure to comply with the CWA or a current or future NPDES permit may result in the initiation of an additional enforcement action pursuant to Section 309(a) of the CWA, 33 U.S.C. §1319(a). You are therefore encouraged to pay close attention to all current permit terms and conditions at all times.
