This is an Addendum to the Administrative Order (Order) issued to the Town of Turnerville (Respondent) on April 14, 2021. The purpose of this letter is to approve the Respondent's May 20, 2024, schedule (Schedule) for coming into consistent compliance with 40 C.F.R. Part 141, Subparts H and T. The Schedule is hereby incorporated into the Order pursuant to paragraph 11. Each milestone and deadline specified below is an enforceable provision of the Order.

Within 10 calendar days of completing all steps included in the above Schedule, please notify the EPA of the project's completion as required by the Order. The Order also requires Respondent to achieve and maintain compliance with 40 C.F.R. Part 141, Subparts H and T, by the final date specified in the approved Schedule. The EPA is authorized to seek penalties if these deadlines are not met. If Respondent has a reasonable basis to believe it may be unable to meet any deadline in the Schedule, it must notify the EPA well in advance of the Scheduled deadline to request an extension. The EPA may, in its discretion, consider granting an extension.
