ORDER GRANTING AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE AN ANSWER TO COMPLAINT AND A STAY ON THE MOTION FOR DISMISSAL OF COMPLAINT FILED BY CO-RESPONDENT HÉCTOR ROGRIGUEZ VALLE

On May 21, 2024, Complainant filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File a Response to "Motion for Dismiss of the Co-Respondent Héctor Rodriguez Valle" ("HRV's Motion to Dismiss"). Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 22.16(b), Complainant's response to HRV's Motion to Dismiss, which was filed on May 6th, was due on May 21, 2024. The Undersigned granted Complainant's Motion by Order effective May 23, 2024 ("May 23rd Order"), granting Complainant an extension through June 5, 2024, to file its response to HRV's Motion to Dismiss.

On May 23, 2024, and subsequent to the filing of the Undersigned's May 23rd Order, Co-Respondent Héctor Rodríguez Valle filed a Second Motion for Extension of Time to File an Answer to the Complaint ("HRV's Second Motion"), requesting a sixty (60) day extension of time to answer and that HRV's Motion to Dismiss be put "on hold" during that time period as well.

Based on the information set forth in HRV's Second Motion, for good cause shown and with the concurrence of Complainant, the Undersigned grants Co-Respondents Héctor Rodríguez Valle and Transporte Rodríguez Asfalto, Inc. ("TRA") extensions of time to file answers to the Complaint through July 22, 2024. During that time period, HRV's Motion to Dismiss will be stayed, and therefore, any due dates for responses and replies to that Motion will be suspended as well.

This Order supersedes the Order issued by the Undersigned on May 23, 2024.
