CONSENT AGREEMENT AND FINAL ORDER

This proceeding for the assessment of a civil penalty was initiated on April 20, 2006, pursuant to pursuant to Section 113(d) of the Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7413(d), when Complainant issued a Complaint and Notice of Opportunity For Hearing ("Complaint") to Quality Chef Foods ("Respondent"). The Complaint charged Respondent with violation of the Chemical Accident Prevention Provisions, and specifically the requirement to submit a Risk Management Plan, 40 C.F.R. Part 68, Subpart G, promulgated pursuant to Section 112(r) of the Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7412(r). The Complaint proposed a total civil penalty of Forty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$49,500.00) against Respondent for the violations.

The parties subsequently entered negotiations in an attempt to settle the allegations contained in the Complaint; this Consent Agreement and Final Order is the result of such negotiations.

CONSENT AGREEMENT

1. Respondent admits the jurisdictional allegations of the Complaint.

- 2. Respondent neither admits nor denies the specific factual allegations contained in the Complaint.
- 3. Respondent consents to the assessment of the stated civil penalty in the Final Order and to the conditions specified in this Consent Agreement.
- 4. Respondent waives any right to contest the allegations and its right to appeal the proposed Final Order accompanying this Consent Agreement.
- 5. Respondent agrees not to contest EPA's jurisdiction in this proceeding or any subsequent proceeding to enforce the terms of this Final Order.
 - 6. Respondent and EPA each agree to bear their own costs and attorney's fees.
- 7. Respondent certifies by the signing of this Consent Agreement and Final Order that to the best of its knowledge, Respondent is presently in compliance with all requirements of Section 112(r) of the Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. § 7412(r), and all regulations promulgated thereunder.
- 8. Nothing contained in the Final Order shall alter or otherwise affect Respondent's obligations to comply with all applicable federal, state and local environmental statutes and regulations and applicable permits.
- 9. The undersigned representative of Respondent certifies he or she is fully authorized to enter the terms and conditions of this Consent Agreement and Final Order and to execute and legally bind Respondent to it.
- 10. The settlement pursuant to this Consent Agreement shall resolve
 Respondent's liability for Federal civil penalties for the violations and facts alleged in the
