# UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR A THIRTY-DAY EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE AN ANSWER

Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 22.7, Respondent, the United States Department of the Army, hereby requests an extension of time to file its answers the Administrative Complaint advanced by Regional Counsel Kenneth C. Schefski in the above-captioned case.

Good cause exists for this extension for the following reasons:

- 1. On June 16, 2020, the Army received the Complaint in this case. An answer is due on or about July 15, 2020.
- 2. Because of ongoing restrictions related to COVID-19 as well as holidays and summer schedules, additional time is needed to coordinate with Army employees and retrieve information to ensure the Army has sufficient information to provide answers and defenses in accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 22.15.
- 3. On July 2, 2020, Army counsel contacted EPA counsel of record to attain EPA's position on a 30 day extension of time. On July 6, 2020, EPA counsel informed Army counsel that EPA does not oppose a 30 day motion for extension of time to file an answer and authorized

the Army to state that this motion for a thirty-day extension is unopposed. Therefore, there is no prejudice to other parties as a result of the requested extension.

Based on the foregoing, the Army respectfully requests an extension of 30 days, to and including August 14, 2020, to file its answer.
