
Dear Mr. Vukovich:

On April 10, 2009, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) issued an Emergency Administrative Order (Order) under section 1431 of the Safe Drinking Water Act (the Act), 40 U.S.C. § 300i, to Colorado Real Estate & Investment Company, owner and/or operator of the Skyline Village MHP public water system (the system). This letter confirms the verbal notice provided to Aimee White, Regional Property Supervisor at Skyline Village MHP, by Shawn McCaffrey of EPA on May 12, 2009, that weekly bacteriological monitoring in the distribution system is no longer required. At this time, the system may resume monthly bacteriological monitoring. This notice is based on bacteriological monitoring conducted on April 20, April 28, May 4, and May 11, 2009 which were analyzed as total coliform negative. The system is required to comply with all other provisions of the Order. Penalties for failing to comply are set forth in the Order.
