On August 9, 2010, the Campbell County Sheriff's office served you with an Administrative Order (the Order) issued by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) ordering you, as owner and/or operator of Bryan's Place, to comply with various regulations issued by EPA under the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA), 42 U.S.C. Section 300f et seq.

Our records indicate that you (Respondent) are in violation of the Order. Among other things, the Order included the following requirements (quoted from item 10 on page 2 of the Order):

Respondent shall monitor the system's water quarterly for total coliform bacteria, as required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.21. Respondent shall report analytical results to EPA within the first 10 days following the month in which sample results were received, as required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.31(a). Respondent shall report any violation of the total coliform monitoring requirements to EPA within 10 days of discovery, as required by 40 C.F.R. § 141.21(g)(2).

EPA has not received total coliform analytical results for 3rd (July-September) quarter 2010. You also failed to report this violation to EPA.

EPA is considering additional enforcement action as a result of your non-compliance with the Order. Violating an Administrative Order may lead to (1) a penalty of up to \$37,500 per day per violation of the Order, and/or (2) a court injunction ordering compliance.
