The Administrative Settlement Agreement and Order on Consent for Treatability Study with an Effective Date of July 6, 2017 ("Agreement") is hereby amended to include the following provision as Section XXX, Paragraph 83:

If Respondent determines that additional work not identified in the Work Plan is appropriate and useful to further the goals of this Agreement, Respondent may submit a written request to EPA's Remedial Project Manager identifying the additional work, explaining how the additional work is appropriate and useful and furthers the goals of this Agreement, and requesting authorization to perform the additional work under this Agreement. If EPA agrees that the additional work is appropriate and useful and furthers the goals of the Agreement, after receipt of the written request, EPA's Remedial Project Manager shall request a work plan for the additional work. Respondent shall implement the work plan upon approval by EPA in accordance with the schedule set forth therein. Respondent shall not proceed with the proposed additional work until EPA's Remedial Project Manager approves the work plan for such work.

All other provisions of the Agreement remain unchanged.
