
On behalf of the Respondent Lawes Coal Company, Inc., kindly accept this letter in support of Respondent's motion for an extension of time until November 20, 2012, to file its Answer to the Petitioner's Complaint, in the above-referenced matter. Please note that Respondent filed a motion for an extension of time under letter dated February 3, 2012, which requested an extension to file an Answer until June 5, 2012. However, the Order granting the extension was not issued until August 22, 2012, and was not sent for service to counsel of record until August 23, 2012. That Order only extended the time to Answer until June 5, 2012. Consequently, Respondent is promptly filing this letter in support of another motion to extend time to Answer in order to allow the parties to continue settlement communications. Based on my recent communications with Mr. Timothy Murphy, Esq., counsel for Petitioner, Mr. Murphy does not oppose this extension request.

Without waiving any defenses and without admitting to any of Petitioner's allegations in its Complaint, Petitioner and Respondent are in the final stages of negotiating the terms of a Consent Decree. Specifically, the parties have agreed on a compliance schedule, and the only remaining component is whether the parties can agree on a monetary settlement amount. Counsel for the Petitioner and Respondent have been in frequent communication with each other regarding the progress.
