This memorandum transmits a Combined Complaint and Consent Agreement (CCCA) proposed to settle violations of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. § 300h *et seq.*, and the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations at 40 C.F.R. part 141. The attached CCCA has been signed by the EPA and Johnson County Moose Lodge #2675 (Respondent), and is now being submitted for your approval. If a Final Order is issued by you, the CCCA, consistent with 40 C.F.R. sections 22.13(b) and 22.18(b), will both commence and resolve the Respondent's civil administrative liability in this matter.

The Respondent is a Wyoming corporation that owns and/or operates the Johnson County Moose Lodge #2675 Public Water System (System) located in Johnson County, Wyoming. The System serves an average of approximately 27 individuals daily at least 60 days out of the year. On June 30, 2014, the EPA issued an Administrative Order (Order) to the Respondent, citing violations of the Drinking Water Regulations. This CCCA would settle the Respondent's alleged Order violations, specifically, numerous failures to monitor for total coliform and to report such violations to the EPA.

Upon consideration of the factors set forth in 42 U.S.C. § 300g-3(b), the EPA has determined that a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,000.00 is appropriate to settle this matter. The proposed settlement is consistent with applicable settlement penalty policies. The Safe Drinking Water Act does not require public notice of this settlement.
