Dear Mayor Thompson:

This is an Addendum to the Administrative Order (Order) issued to the Town of Cokeville (Respondent) on December 14, 2023. On January 8, 2024, Respondent submitted a proposed plan and schedule to come into compliance with 40 C.F.R. Part 141, Subparts H and T by switching permanently to an alternate source of water that is not subject to these requirements. This letter serves as an approval of Respondent's proposed schedule (Schedule), which is hereby incorporated into the Order pursuant to paragraphs 21-22. Each milestone and deadline specified below is an enforceable provision of the Order.

Within 10 calendar days of completing all steps included in the above Schedule, please notify the EPA of the project's completion as required by the Order. The Order also requires Respondent to achieve and maintain compliance with the requirements of 40 C.F.R. Part 141, Subparts H and T, by the final date specified in the approved Schedule. The EPA is authorized to seek penalties if these deadlines are not met. If Respondent has a reasonable basis to believe it may be unable to meet any deadline in the Schedule, it must notify the EPA well in advance of the Scheduled deadline to request an extension. The EPA may, in its discretion, consider granting an extension.

As a reminder, you are required to provide the EPA with quarterly progress reports by the 10th calendar day of the month following each relevant quarter.
