**FOR RESPONDENT TO FILE ANSWER**


Complainant, the Director of the Air and Waste Management Division of EPA Region 7, filed the Complaint and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing (Complaint) in this matter on January 29, 2018, which was served upon Respondent, Loganbill Ag Services, LLC, on February 8, 2018. After two attempts at certified mail delivery (Article No.: 7014 1200 0000 6127 1084), service of the Complaint was made to the registered agent for Respondent on February 8, 2018, by United Parcel Service.

Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. 22.15(a), Respondent Loganbill Ag Services, LLC, is required to file an Answer to the Complaint no later than 30 days from date of service, or in this case, by March 12, 2018. Counsel for Complainant has contacted the representatives for Respondent (Messrs. Ryan and Kent Loganbill), and the parties hereby jointly request until April 20, 2018 for Respondent to file the required Answer. Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. 22.7(b), the parties believe that the reasons and good cause for this request are as follows:

1. Respondent is not represented by counsel;

2. Respondent has claimed financial hardship and additional time is required for Respondent to gather and submit financial information for evaluation by Complainant to support this claim;
3. Counsel for Complainant will be unavailable between March 9 and March 26, 2018; and
4. If the parties are able to reach agreement on the terms of settlement, time will be required for preparation and execution of a Consent Agreement and Final Order.




